



## Good Standing Policy

The Lakelands Primary School Good Standing Policy has been established to allow for the development and nurturing of all students. A framework is provided around which students will be able to develop skills that contribute to them becoming lifelong learners.

**Good Standing** is a status all Lakelands students are granted at the beginning of each term.

Students with **Good Standing** are eligible to participate in a whole school reward at the end of each term.

It is the responsibility of each student to maintain their **Good Standing**

To maintain **Good Standing** students must:

- Comply with school expectations
- Comply with individual classroom expectations

A student's **Good Standing** can be lost and re-earned throughout a term through the following ways;

Strike against Good Standing	Earn back	Loss of Good Standing
If sent to Admin to complete a Reflection Sheet	Two weeks with limited Take 5s (this is up to teacher discretion based on each individual student)	If this occurs <b>3</b> times in a term without being earned back
If sent to office for extreme behaviours	Two weeks with no further extreme behaviours	If this occurs <b>2</b> times in a term without being earned back
		<b>Suspension</b> results in immediate loss of Good Standing which cannot be earned back.

Students who lose their **Good Standing** status will lose the right to participate in whole school rewards for that term.

**Good Standing** is restored at the beginning of each term.
